	Managing our waste Landfill alternatives, better recycling, minimise waste.		Transparency in Council Support transparent and evidenced based decision making through shared data.
	Community welfare Advocating for programs and support to reduce harm.		Business attraction Elevate our identity as an innovation hub and business-friendly city.
	Arts, culture and tourism Build our reputation as an arts, culture and tourism destination.		Emergency preparedness Maintain systems and capacity to manage and respond to emergency events.
	Open space management Provide well designed, suitable, multi-use open spaces and infrastructure.		Customer experience Transform customer service to be easy to access and seamless.
